- At the Commission's request, the Department of Personnel (DOP) evaluated the Executive Branch positions in November 2006. DOP used the Willis Point Factor Evaluation System to conduct the evaluations. The Willis system is used extensively in state government to evaluate executive and managerial positions.
 - The Committee on Agency Officials' Salaries (SCOAS) establishes a maximum salary for each position within six Plateaus (A through G). The governor then sets the salary for each position within the maximum set by SCOAS.
 - Data in this chart shows only the agency heads' positions that are ranked in Plateaus A, A-, B+, and B because the duties and responsibilities of the positions in these plateaus are comparable to the elected officials' positions.
 - Salaries for the Appointed Agency Heads and the Elected Officials are as of September 2008.
